## What are Nouns?

- Noun is a Person (TONI), place (SCHOOL), or thing (BOOK)
- There are two kinds:

Common nouns :	Names of things you can see and touch and are countable.
	- apple, mountain, boy
■ Proper nouns :	Names of a person, place, or thing that
	starts with a capital letter
	- Toni, Canada, Christmas

• nouns can be **plural** (more than one) or **singular** (only one):

	Singular (only one)	Plural (more than one)
We add <u>-s</u> to the noun to	apple	apple <u>s</u>
make it plural	mountain	mountain <u>s</u>
	duck	duck <u>s</u>

• We add <u>-es</u> to a noun to make it plural if the noun is <u>irregular</u> (provide examples)

	Singular (only one)	Plural (more than one)
We add <u>-es</u> to the noun to	fox	fox <u>es</u>
make it plural	glass	glass <u>es</u>
	beach	beach <u>es</u>

	Singular	Plural	Example in a sentence
-S	duck	duck <u>s</u>	I have three rubber ducks
-es	glass	glass <u>es</u>	There are two glass <u>es</u> on the table
