- Review for learning modal verbs (CLB Level Intermediate-advanced)

Students would

- Talk in small groups or work in teams
- Students can work in pairs, if the class is small

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Objective

- Learners have the opportunity to practice creating and recognizing different modal verbs that have been taught in class.

Outcome

- Learn new vocabulary or review topics covered in class
- Increase student confidence in speaking, listening, reading, and writing

Activity

- What you need:
 - Modal verb cards, pencil & paper, OR, mini white boards and markers (anything that students can use to create words or sentences)
 - Cards with different modal verbs
 - You can give the students a timer (lower levels you can just have them give words and no timer).
 - Dice
- Set-up/How to play:
 - Students can sit at a table in one group, or in pairs (depends on the size of the class)
 - students are then asked to roll the dice and write that amount of sentences as they can using the modal verb that they picked up (card)
 - students can then practice speaking/ reading skills by reading the words or sentences to their group
- Considerations:
 - Class size, level of the class, and time constraints
